Predicted grades must be official predictions, issued on school/college letterhead and signed by an appropriate person (head of careers, head of year etc).
- 3. <u>IF APPLYING AFTER COMPLETION OF SCHOOL LEAVING QUALIFICATIONS (EG: A-LEVELS, IB, PRE-U DIPLOMA)</u>: Original certificates for GCSE and school-leaving qualifications.
- 4. A personal statement (please aim for a maximum of 400-500 words).

### Supporting documents required for postgraduate (masters) applications:

- 1. A photocopy of the personal details page of your passport
- 2. Original academic transcripts for each year of your degree (a transcript is an official list, issued by the university, of the subjects you've studied and the grades obtained). Transcripts should carry an explanation of the university's grading system on the back. If they don't, please provide one separately.
- 3. Original bachelors completion certificate.
- 4. A CV, detailing any relevant work experience.
- 5. A personal statement (please aim for a maximum of 400-500 words).

- 1. If further material or documents are required, Study Options will be in touch to request these after we have received and checked the application.
- 2. All academic documents must be submitted as originals, we can't accept photocopies. We'll make certified copies to send with your application, and will return the originals by recorded delivery. To ensure their safe arrival, please send your documents to us by recorded delivery.

# Application for Admission Information

## What you need to know before applying for admission

We recommend that you familiarise yourself with the details of the programme you are interested in BEFORE you apply for admission. Students wishing to enrol in a limited entry course should apply for admission by the specified deadline.

### When to apply

#### **Undergraduate Applications**

Semester 1 (February start): 31<sup>st</sup> October Semester 2 (July start): 31<sup>st</sup> March

#### **Postgraduate Applications**

At least 6 months before the intended start date.

PhD and master's research students may begin their studies at any time during the year with the approval of their supervisor.

You should apply as early as possible to give yourself maximum preparation time for visa application, fee payment, travel and accommodation arrangements. Late applications may be processed, but we cannot guarantee that a decision will be made in time for you to make the necessary arrangements to start your studies here.
