- Opportunities to apply for further sports scholarships as a King's resident

Who is eligible? You must be:

- A UK national who completed school in 2025 or 2026*
- Competing at a high level in rugby, netball or rowing
- Able to meet academic (and any other) entry requirements for your chosen undergraduate degree at UQ

*Dual nationals of the UK and Australia are not eligible for this award
